Information about Anne Marie Tipper

Anne-Marie has worked within the local authority tier 2 CAMHS service with children; young people and families with complex emotional needs. Her therapeutic work has been with a wide range of emotional and behavioural difficulties. These have included diagnosed and undiagnosed ADHD, ASD, ODD, anxiety and complex mental health conditions.

She was the lead therapist for looked after and adopted children and trauma and attachment specialist, and has delivered group training for adoptive parents and foster carers, as well as guiding social care staff in their understanding of the difficulties these families face.

Information about Ian Wright

Ian has been working in the addiction field for over 13 years and has set up and managed 2 agencies providing individual counselling and group work and currently manages and provides counselling for gamblers or those affected by somebody else's gambling and worked with families of drug & alcohol users. He has designed and implemented relapse prevention groups for alcohol and drug users.
